# AMENDMENTS APPROVAL

## Italian American Club of Livonia

#### **ACCORDING TO ARTICLE X11 SECTION 1 AMENDMENT READS:**

Amendments to the Constitution and/or By-Laws of the Italian American Club of Livonia shall be made only on the recommendation of the Board of Directors and the approval of two-thirds of the members present at a meeting of the general membership.

The following changes to the Constitution of the Italian American Club of Livonia will be brought before the general membership of the Club at the General Membership Meeting scheduled for **Wednesday**, **April 19**, **2023** 

Amendments to be voted on.

1. **Article III Section 7** – All members and their spouses shall be prohibited from being employed by the club in a full-time management position.

**Proposed Amendment Change** No member can serve on the Board of Directors while employed by the Italian Club of Livonia.

2. Article V1 Section 2 – All officers shall hold their respective offices for the term of two (2) years following their election and until their successors take office. There are no term limits except - The office of the President shall be limited to (4) consecutive terms, for a total of (8) years, although he or she may run again at a later date. To be eligible to be elected as an Officer, a member must have served as a Director for a minimum of two (2) years. If no candidate possessing this qualification is duly nominated for any officer position(s), (the "open position(s) than any member in good standing, who was duly nominated for such an "open position", may be placed on the ballot for that position. Notwithstanding any of the foregoing, any current director is qualified for nomination to any officer position.

**Proposed Amendment Change** - All officers shall hold their respective offices for the term of two (2) years following their election and until their successors take office. There are no term limits except - The office of the President shall be limited to (3) consecutive terms, for a total of (6) years, although he or she may run again at a later date. If there is no one running for the office of President, the board can make an exception for the Past President to run for an additional 2 years. To be eligible to be elected as an Officer, a member must have served as a Director for a minimum of two (2) years. If no candidate possessing this qualification is duly nominated for any officer position(s), (the "open position(s) than any member in good standing, who was duly nominated for such an "open position", may be placed on the ballot for that position. Notwithstanding any of the foregoing, any current director is qualified for nomination to any officer position.

3. **Addition to Article V1 Section 2 (above)** - A person must be of Italian Ancestry to run for the office of the President or Vice President.

4. Article V Section 1 (a) - The affairs of Italian American Club of Livonia, Inc. shall be conducted by the Board of Directors, which shall be composed of 6 Officers elected by the general assembly to the Executive Committee, the immediate Past President and 5 (CHANGE TO 4) Directors elected by the general assembly and 5 (CHANGE TO 2) Directors appointed by the Executive Committee to serve a term of office for a period of two (2) years. Submitted by Tony Rotondo

5. Article VI Section 4 (a) - There shall be elected or appointed from the membership at large 40 (CHANGE TO 6) directors, 5 (CHANGE TO 2) directors shall be appointed by the Executive Committee and 5 (CHANGE TO 4) directors shall be elected by the general assembly. The 5 (CHANGE TO 4) members on the ballot for directors who receive the highest number of votes shall each be elected. In the event a member who is elected a director shall be serving on the Board of Directors in another capacity, said member shall forego the director position and the member receiving the next highest number of votes shall be elected a director. If there are not enough candidates to fill the elected director positions, the Executive Committee shall appoint any vacancies.

Per essere eleggibile come funzionario, un membro deve aver prestato servizio come Direttore per un minimo di due (2) anni. Se Nessun candidato in possesso di questa qualifica e debitamente nominato per una o piu posizioni di funzionario (la/e "posizione/iaperta/e di qualsiasi membro in regola, che e stato debitamente nominato per tale "posizione aperta", puo essre inserito nel ballattaggio per quella posizione Nonostante quanto sopra, qualsiasi amministratore in carica e qualificator per la nomina a qualsiasi posizione di funzionario.

Modifica dell'emendamento proposto I dirigenti (officers) avranno un mandato di una durata di due (2) anni a partire dalla data di elezione alla sostituzione del proprio successore. Non esistono limiti di mandato (term limits) eccezion fatta per il Presidente il quale puo' rimanere in carica per tre (3) mandati consecutivi per un totale di sei (6) anni. La carica puo' essere ripresa dopo una pausa di almeno un mandato. In caso che nessuno si canditi per presidente, il Consiglio Direttivo ha la facolta' di invocare una eccezione alla regola e permettere la candidatura del presidente uscente per ulteriori due (2) anni. Una persona puo' candidarsi alla carica di Dirigente (officer) solamente se ha compiuto almeno due (2) anni in qualita' di Direttore. In caso non ci siano persone con le dovute qualifiche, la carica di Dirigente rimasta "scoperta" verra' inserita nel plico elettorale (ballot) per le prossime elezioni. Si precisa intanto che tutte le persone che coprono la carica di Direttore sono idonei (qualified) alla carica di Dirigente.





IACL Club Member **Dr. JOSEPH PINTO**January 26, 1928 – April 5, 2023

Doctor Joseph F. Pinto of Plymouth, Michigan passed away on April 5, 2023 peacefully and in his sleep which he told us all was the way he wanted to leave this earth. He is now reunited with Heather, his loving wife of 53 year. The legend of Papa Joe began when he was born in Amantea, Italy on January 26, 1928 to Pasquale and Giuseppina Pinto. A self-proclaimed "stubborn pain-in-the-ass", he vexed his poor mother, who raised Joe and his beloved older brother, John, virtually alone as Pasquale had moved to America before Joe was born. For the first seven years of his life, he lived without a father, electricity, running water or common sense as he picked fights throughout his hometown and often tried to knock down his "enemies" houses with a stick (without any success). In 1935, his

father, Pasquale, had saved enough money that he brought Giuseppina, John and Joe to their adopted home in Dearborn. As tough as life had been in Italy, his introduction to life in the US was just as hard. Two weeks after his family's arrival in the US, in the middle of the Great Depression, Pasquale lost his job and John and Joe were expected to help support the family. Throughout his childhood, Joe sold newspapers, swept floors, drove mail trucks, sold records at the local department store and acted as translator for his dad for his various real estate endeavors. In addition, while initially forbidden by Giuseppina from fighting in the United States, Joe took more than a few beatings from local bullies due to his Italian heritage. When his mother finally understood what was happening, she allowed Joseph to "take the gloves off" and he quickly established himself as a "tough SOB" who would never back down from a fight. According to Joe, "no one messed with him." His drive and determination were second to none.

Joseph attended Fordson High School where he made many friends and walked uphill, both ways, to and from the school. While not the greatest student on the planet, he worked extremely hard and, with the help of his family, he enrolled at Wayne State University and became the first member of the Pinto family to go to college. Then, with the help of the United States Air Force, he offered up two years of service for the opportunity to attend the University of Detroit Dental School where he graduated in 1953 as a Doctor of Dental Surgery (DDS). For two years after his graduation, he served in the USAF in Greenland eventually attaining the rank of Captain and base commander. Upon returning to the US, he taught dentistry part-time at the University of Michigan while establishing his proprietary practice. He would gladly volunteer that there was not a better dentist in the Detroit area and he served his patients at his office in Garden City, Michigan until he retired in 1994. He also served as the President of the Detroit District Dental Society and was a member of the Board of Directors of Delta Dental.

Much to his mother's chagrin, Joseph was a bachelor until he was 40 years old but like a good Italian boy, he lived at home. Always the life of the party, Joseph was often put in charge of the "hospitality room" at dental conventions. While attending a dental conference in Chicago, he met a lovely hygienist named Heather Duke. That first meeting was inauspicious as Heather thought Joe was a bit "in love with himself." Through a miracle and some perseverance on his part, Heather also fell in love with Joe and they were married on December 30, 1966 so Joe could claim an extra dependent tax exemption for that year. Joseph and Heather didn't waste time starting a family and they had three boys in the span of 35 months. All three boys were lucky that they turned out 51% Italian even though Heather had no Italian genes. He passed on more than his Italian heritage by instilling in each of his sons the same drive and determination to be successful in everything they did. He was a tremendous role model, father and grandfather. In what has become an incredible love story, Joe and Heather stayed deeply in love for 53 years of marriage and beyond. He missed Heather desperately for the last three years. While we are sure that our mom is happy to have him by her side at this time, she is sure to miss how quiet heaven was before he got there.

Joseph had many hobbies and traits that he shared with the family. He was an avid hunter and fisherman, life-long golfer and an amazing cook (although he was not very good at cleaning up after his cooking benders). His "Sunday Soups" where he emptied the contents of the refrigerator and mixed it with some sort of tomato sauce were delicious but could never be replicated. And his version of frittata, a fried pasta, cheese and sausage delicacy was a staple in their house (but, per his brother Johnny, it could have always used one more egg).

He was probably best at directing traffic, being the boss, yelling at the TV, being a grumpy old bear, lecturing all of us about what we should or shouldn't be doing and telling us how he could fix the world if given the chance. Mostly he was very proud that he was right 99.9% of the time. He was always one to root for the underdog (insert any Detroit sports team here, most notably the Lions) and would never back down from a fight for the "little guy" (even death had to come get him while he was sleeping). While he was concerned by the way the world was moving (what 95-year old isn't), he was a believer that the USA was the greatest country in the world because where else could a poor immigrant have such success. He lived the American dream. He always said that his purpose in life was to leave the Earth, "a bit better than it was before he got here." He did so. He was a friend to many and often bemoaned that so many of his friends got to heaven before he did. Joseph loved and will be dearly missed by his extended family and friends. He loved the Italian American Club especially the four times a year he got to eat there for free. To him, that alone was worth the price of membership in the club. # FOUR TRAVERSE CITY SCHOOLS VOCALISTS SWEEP TOP PRIZES AT VERDI OPERA'S VOCAL COMPETITION

The 29th edition of the Italian Songs and Arias Vocal Competition for Michigan High School Students was held at the Italian American Club of Livonia Banquet Hall on Sunday, April 30. The Concert of the Finalists proved to be as exciting an event as ever. Four very talented vocalists from two Traverse City schools swept the top four prizes. The \$1000 First Place Prize was awarded to Isaiah Gallegos, of Traverse City West Senior High School, who impressed the enthusiastic audience with spirited renditions of Mozart's aria "Deh vieni alla finestra" from the opera "Don Giovanni", and "Si`, tra i ceppi" from Handel's "Berenice". There was a tie for the second place prize. It was deemed that the performances of two singers, both from Traverse City West S.H.S., Caleb Mienk's rendering of F.P. Tosti's popular art song "Ideale" and Mozart's aria "Vieni, vieni, o mia Ninetta" from his early opera "La Finta Semplice", as well

as Piper Dee's captivating interpretations of S.Donaudy's song "Amorosi miei giorni" and F.P.Tosti's "L'ultimo bacio", accompanied by her father at the piano

- were deemed worthy of each receiving a 2nd place \$500 award. Renowned pianist Kevin Bylsma was the collaborator of all the other finalists. Kathryn Haag, from Traverse City Central H.S. was the recipient of the 3rd place award of \$300 for her sensitive interpretations of the beautiful neapolitan song "A vucchella", by F.P. Tosti, and of Mozart's aria "Batti, batti, o bel Masetto" from "Don Giovanni". The other much applauded finalists, were considered of equally high merit, performing songs and arias by Beethoven, Cesti, Cimara, Donaudy, Giordani, Gluck, Scarlatti, and Verdi. They were: Katelin Anason, from Stoney Creek H.S.; Sloane O'Neill, from Grosse Pointe North H.S.; Mollie Ritchie, from Saint Francis H.S. in Traverse City; Lily LaFaive and Sydney Kane, both from Traverse City West S.H.S.; and Molly Levin, from International Academy in Bloomfield Hills who, unfortunately, had to cancel her appearance at the last moment due to illness. Each received \$100.

This esteemed statewide competition is sponsored by the Verdi Opera Theatre of Michigan, with major funding for the Concert of the Finalists being generously provided by the Italian American Club of Livonia Charitable Foundation, and additional funding by Robert DiGiovanni and Judith Steeh, as well as with assistance from the Dante Alighieri Society of Michigan, the Detroit Opera, the Italian American Cultural Society in Clinton Township, and under the auspices of the Consulate of Italy in Detroit, whose Consul, Allegra Baistrocchi, was present at the concert. The distinguished judges of the competition were: Professor George Shirley, a Detroit music icon of New York's Metropolitan Opera fame and recipient of the National Medal of Arts, the nation's highest public artistic honor; soprano Louise Toppin, acclaimed for her operatic, orchestral, oratorio and recital performances world-wide; and soprano Caitlin Lynch, a winner of this competition when she was a high school student at Marian H.S. in Bloomfield Hills and who is now captivating audiences with her portrayals of both classic and contemporary operas on stages around the world. At the end of the event all three judges addressed the students with words of praise for their singing and later met with each contestant to provide feedback on their performances and to offer encouragement on their continuing studies. The aim of the competition is to assist and help develop young students in the challenging world of classical music and to promote appreciation for the Italian language, opera and art songs. John Zaretti, President of the Verdi Opera, thanked the audience for their enthusiastic response, as well as the teachers who mentored and prepared the ten finalists so well for the competition, and the sponsors for their very valued support which has made possible the awarding of a total of over \$75,000 in prizes through the years. Many outstanding young vocalists, - such as Caitlin Lynch, tenor Michael Fabiano, bass-baritone Jesus Murillo, Mezzosoprano Raehann Bryce-Davis, and others - have been featured in Verdi Opera concerts and are now singing with major opera companies in the USA and abroad - including our own dynamic Detroit Opera. # 2023/2024 SCHOLARSHIP

## **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. Candidates must <u>establish Italian Ancestry</u> and reside in Southeast Lower Michigan.
- 2. Candidates must have completed their <u>junior year of high school in the spring</u> <u>of 2023</u>, have a <u>B average</u> in all classes. Due to Michigan's regulations regarding the option to opt out of the ACT and SAT exams for the pandemic year, the IACLCF will not consider the scores of the ACT and/or SAT a requirement for evaluating the applicant's score. However, the number of Advanced Placement (AP) courses and Honor courses will be taken into consideration
- 3. Candidate's need for financial assistance will be considered.
- 4. Candidates must be outstanding in character, integrity and leadership.

All candidates who satisfy the above requirements may compete for the limited number of IACL Charitable Foundation Scholarships awarded annually. The final selection of scholarship recipient rests with the Scholarship Committee.

Application will be available after April 1, 2023, of the candidate's junior year in high school. The completed application must be received by October 31, 2023.



# ORECCHIETTE WITH SAUSAGE AND CHICORY

#### **Ingredients**

1 pound orecchiette

¼ cup extra-virgin olive oil

1 pound sweet Italian sausage, casings removed

2 cloves garlic thinly sliced ½ teaspoon crushed red pepper

1 pound chicory or escarole, coarsely chopped and washed

1 teaspoon Kosher salt

 $1\ \mbox{cup}$  chicken stock or low-sodium broth  $^1\!\!/_{\!\!4}$  cup grated pecorino, plus more for serving

2 tablespoons shredded mint

#### **Directions**

1. Bring a pot of salted water to a boil. , and top with more cheese!

1.In a large pot of boiling salted water, cook the pasta until al dente. Drain well.

2. Meanwhile, in a large, deep skillet, heat 2 tablespoons of the olive oil until shimmering. Add the sausage and cook over moderately high heat, breaking it up with a wooden spoon, until browned, about 7 minutes. Using a slotted spoon, transfer the sausage to a plate.

3. Add the garlic, crushed red pepper and the remaining 2 tablespoons of olive oil to the skillet and cook until fragrant, about 1 minute. Add the chicory with any water clinging to the leaves and season with salt. Cover and cook until wilted, about 2 minutes. Uncover and cook until the chicory is tender and the liquid has evaporated, about 5 minutes longer.

4. Add the pasta to the skillet along with the sausage, chicken stock and pecorino and cook over moderate heat, stirring constantly, until the liquid is slightly reduced and creamy, about 3 minutes. Stir in the mint and serve right away, passing extra cheese at the table.


