RICOTTA ORANGE POUND CAKE WITH PROSECCO STRAWBERRIES

Ingredients

 $1 \frac{1}{2}$ sticks unsalted butter, at room temperature, plus more for greasing

1 ½ cups cake flour

2 ½ teaspoons baking powder

1 teaspoon kosher salt

1 ½ cups fresh ricotta cheese

1 ½ cups plus 2 tablespoons granulated sugar

3 large eggs

2 tablespoons amaretto liqueur

1 teaspoon pure vanilla extract

1 teaspoon finely grated orange zest

1 pound strawberries, hulled and quartered

2 tablespoons Prosecco

Confectioners' sugar, for dusting

Lightly sweetened whipped cream, for serving

Directions

Preheat the oven to 350°F. Butter a deep, 9-inch round cake pan. In a bowl, whisk the cake flour, baking powder and salt. In another bowl, beat the ricotta, 1½ sticks of butter and 1½ cups of the sugar at medium-high speed until smooth. Beat in the eggs one at a time until just incorporated, then beat in the amaretto, vanilla, and orange zest. Beat in the dry ingredients in three batches just until incorporated.

Scrape the batter into the prepared pan and bake for 50 minutes, until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out with a few crumbs. Transfer to a rack to cool for 20 minutes; unmold and let cool completely.

In a bowl, toss the strawberries with the Prosecco and remaining 2 tablespoons of sugar and let stand at room temperature until juicy, about 30 minutes.

Dust the pound cake with confectioners' sugar. Cut into wedges and serve with the strawberries and whipped cream.



2023/2024 SCHOLARSHIP

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for an IACL Charitable Foundation Scholarship all candidates must meet the following requirements

Italian Ancestry, Academics, Financial Need and Character

- 1. Candidates must <u>establish Italian Ancestry</u> and reside in Southeast Lower Michigan.
- 2. Candidates must have completed their <u>junior year of high school in the spring</u> <u>of 2023</u>, have a <u>B average</u> in all classes. Due to Michigan's regulations regarding the option to opt out of the ACT and SAT exams for the pandemic year, the IACLCF will not consider the scores of the ACT and/or SAT a requirement for evaluating the applicant's score. However, the number of Advanced Placement (AP) courses and Honor courses will be taken into consideration
- 3. Candidate's need for financial assistance will be considered.
- 4. Candidates must be outstanding in character, integrity and leadership.

All candidates who satisfy the above requirements may compete for the limited number of IACL Charitable Foundation Scholarships awarded annually. The final selection of scholarship recipient rests with the Scholarship Committee.

Application will be available after April 1, 2023, of the candidate's junior year in high school. The completed application must be received by October 31, 2023.




