### **RICOTTA PIE**

Submitted by Gerryanna Luscri

### Ingredients

1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cups graham cracker crumbs 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup granulated sugar 6 tbs unsalted butter melted 4 cups ricotta cheese, drained 4 large eggs 1 tsp vanilla extract zest of 1 lemon 2 tbs flour

### Directions

Preheat oven to 350.

In a mixing bowl, combine graham cracker crumbs, 1/4 cup sugar and melted butter for the crust. Mix until the crumbs are evenly coated with the butter. Press the crumb mixture into the bottom and slightly up the sides of a 9-inch pan to create the crust.

In another bowl, beat the ricotta cheese until it is smooth and creamy before adding the sugar and flour to combine well.

Beat in the eggs, one at a time, and then stir in the vanilla extract and citrus zest.

Pour the ricotta filling into the pan of the prepared crust.

Bake in the preheated oven for about 60-75 minutes or until the edges are set and the center is slightly jiggly. Turn off the ove and leave the pie inside with the oven door slightly ajar for about an hour to prevent cracking as it cools. Remove the pie from the oven and let it cool before refrigerating for several hours or overnight. Once chilled and set, carefully remove the pie from the pan to serve.



Maria immigrated to the United States from Italy with her parents and brother at a very young age. In her new country, she learned that education was vitally important and began to develop her knowledge, skills

and capabilities. She earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Accounting at Detroit College of Business now known as Davenport University, a Masters Degree in Taxation and Studies in International Finance from Walsh College. The degrees allowed her to teach accounting classes at college level. Her career expanded to working in the fields of accounting and financial management, holding management positions with companies in the automotive design, engineering services, residential building industries in the USA, and special assignment in German for an American corporation. She worked as an accountant and tax specialist with public accounting firms and as a consult with an Italian company with operations in USA. Maria has always believed to give back to society the support and help she received in the years in USA by being active with academic, professional, youth and immigration non-profit organizations. For several years Maria has been extensively involved in promoting Italian language and culture in southeast Michigan by serving on the boards of numerous nonprofit organizations - the most known: AMIT, Italian American Cultural Society, Verdi Opera Theatre, NOI Foundation, and Dante Alighieri Society. In 2000 Maria joined the IACL and was appointed as a director on the Club Board. In 2010 she served on the Finance Committee. In 2012 she was nominated vice president of the IACL Charitable Foundation and became president in 2015 and continued to serve in that role until she became treasurer. Maria remained passionate about partnering with other non-profit organizations to advance Italian culture and sponsoring worthy causes and programs in the community. She emphasized the importance of offering generous college scholarship to students of Italian descent for an advanced education for building a successful future. Maria was optimistic and believed if we give the deserved recognition and guidance to our next generation, they will be enthusiastic and join us in the endeavors of carrying on our mission in the future. In 1994 Mara was honored with the title of "Cavaliere" from the Italian Republic and in subsequent years she was the recipient of the Dante Distinctive Citizen Award, a Special Tribute from the State of Michigan, and the Distinguished Alumni Award from the Detroit College of Business.

Maria was a pioneer and a staunch advocate for women's rights. She fought long and hard against what she believed to be an unfair and patriarchal rule by the San Marino Club prohibiting independent membership to women. Her battle - and by extension the battle of many other women who will come after her - was won when the Club posthumously accepted Maria to be the first woman ever to be a member of the club.



# **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

To be eligible for an IACL Charitable Foundation Scholarship all candidates must meet the following requirements

Italian Ancestry, Academics, Financial Need and Character

- 1. Candidates must establish Italian Ancestry and reside in Southeast Lower Michigan.
- 2. Candidates must have completed their junior year of high school in the spring of <u>2024</u>, have at least a <u>B average</u> in all classes. Due to Michigan's regulations regarding the option to opt out of the ACT and SAT exams, the IACLCF will not consider the scores of the ACT and/or SAT a requirement for evaluating the applicant's score. However, the number of Advanced Placement (AP) courses and Honor courses will be taken into consideration
- 3. Candidate's need for financial assistance will be considered.
- 4. Candidates must be outstanding in character, integrity and leadership.

All candidates who satisfy the above requirements may compete for the limited number of IACL Charitable Foundation Scholarships awarded annually. The final selection of scholarship recipient rests with the Scholarship Committee.

Application will be available after May 1, 2024, of the candidate's junior year in high school. The completed application must be received by October 31, 2024.
